



## FACILITY USE AGREEMENT

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### Aquatic Facility Policies

1. **For Splash Pad**, no food allowed in splash area. **For Pool**, guest will have use of the pool, locker rooms, and pool sundeck. Food and beverages must stay in the designated area only. Lounge chairs are not available at this time.
2. Lifeguards are responsible for enforcing safety rules and responding to emergencies. Guest is responsible for the safety and behavior of yourself and children.
3. Staff will instruct all swimmers when to enter/exit the water. Guests must exit the water 15 minutes before the rental time is over.
4. Blue Island Park District is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
5. Only clean footwear, baby strollers, or wheelchairs will be allowed in the pool area or bathhouse. No bicycles, scooters, roller blade shoes, or skateboards at pool area/locker rooms.
6. Proper swim attire required. Males are to wear swimming trunks with a liner and females are to wear a bathing suit. NO khakis, cut-offs, shorts, gym shorts, board shorts without lining, baseball shorts, jean material, etc. may be worn. ALL apparel worn in the pool must be clean. Girls may wear shirts over bathing suits, no underwear, shorts, or thongs allowed. ALL children who are not toilet trained shall wear specially designed swimming diapers. Everyone must wear a mask/face covering in the facility and on deck but not in the water.
7. NO flotation devices of any kind are allowed in the pool except for the United States Coast Guard Lifejackets. Soft toys and flotation devices will be allowed at the discretion of the pool management.
8. Perfumes, soap, or other material which might create hazardous conditions or interfere with the efficient operation of the swimming pool shall not be permitted.
9. Admission shall be refused to all persons having any contagious disease, infectious conditions or any other condition which has the appearance of being infectious. If a person shows any symptoms such as a cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fever, chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat or new loss of taste or smell, they may be denied entry into the facility. This includes persons with excessive sunburn, abrasions that have not healed, corn plasters, bunion pads, adhesive tape, rubber bandages or other bandages of any kind.
10. Temperature checks will be required upon entry.
11. All guests must practice social distancing at a minimum of 6 feet at all times.
12. **No glass allowed.** Alcohol and smoking is strictly prohibited.
13. The aquatic facility water is NOT suitable for drinking; avoid swallowing water.
14. Personal conduct within the aquatic facility must be such that the safety of self and others is not jeopardized. No running, boisterous or rough play, profanity or health violation is permitted. If an individual has to be asked to stop dangerous behavior, they will be asked to leave for the day. Management also reserves the right to eject anyone for misconduct that is not listed. Daily fees will be revoked without refunds.
15. Diving is not permitted except in designated area, caution shall be exercised in the use of diving facilities.
16. **Blue Island Park District will only close the pool for lightning or thundering in the area, if the air temperature does not rise above 62 degrees Fahrenheit, as well as rain obscuring the water's clarity or for safety issues as determined by the Pool Manager.**
17. If the pool has to remain closed for longer than thirty (30) minutes due to weather, the pool will be closed for the remainder of the session.
