#### 3. Directors Report:

- a. Spring/Summer Brochure. With the end of Covid, Recreation Department is working on creating returning and new programs. Commissioners reviewed the program guide draft. It is recommended to bring back a physical brochure at least once a year. Searching for a company to help design and mail to residents, with the bulk of cost would be postage. Suggestion was made to place a double-sided sheet in the water bills.
- b. Successful Holiday Season. Started with the Parade Day, Santa train was sold out, Santa stocking delivered 20 stocking and the Santa house were popular. Senior lunch served 50 seniors. It was stated that brochures can be placed around town in local businesses and local schools to help distribution and save on postage. Commissioners agree to create brochure.
- c. Ice Rink. With current weather, ice rink will not be ready until after Christmas. Once ice is set, ice rink will be manned by Park District Security and lifeguards. Blue Island Hockey League is interested in renting ice rink after public skating has ended.

Director Ruthenberg stated he did not want to purchase a used vehicle and they were on a waitlist for a new truck. Ken Bereta is repairing ATV, Gator and Kubota. Commissioners are requesting a list of equipment and their status of conditions and repairs, plus dates on all machinery be present to them for assessment. Possible purchases to be made this year. Question regarding boiler conditions and repairs for both the main field house and pool and heater for pool house. Memorial field house only 10 years old, pool heater still needs repairs.
- e. Master Plan was discussed, down to two companies for presentations.
